

ACCEPTANCE CRITERIA FOR ASBESTOS AND ASBESTOS CONTAMINATED WASTE MATERIAL

The transporter **MUST** contact the scale by phone 515-333-4448 on the scheduled delivery date **prior** to delivery to confirm that site conditions allow for the delivery of the asbestos waste materials.

Asbestos containing materials will be accepted on Monday-Friday between 6:30 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. In the event of inclement weather or other unavoidable circumstances, Metro Waste Authority will coordinate alternative delivery schedules every third business day.

A Waste Shipment Record (Asbestos Waste Manifest) signed by the generator and the hauler **MUST** accompany the shipment.

Asbestos and asbestos contaminated waste **MUST** be adequately wetted, sealed in leak tight containers or wrapping, and labeled.

All vehicles must be off-loaded by hand or other pre-approved methods with extreme care, under no circumstances can packaging be damaged during unloading.

Tipping of roll-off containers containing asbestos wastes will not be permitted unless it can be demonstrated to the satisfaction of the Operations Manager that emissions will not occur.

Upon arrival at the scale house, the driver of the disposal vehicle will advise the attendant that the vehicle contains asbestos containing materials and that a scheduled delivery has been arranged.
