



## Shingle Recycling Program

### Drivers, please share with your boss.

- Beginning immediately, the Metro Park West Landfill will start a shingle recycling pilot program. The shingles will be ground and used to make asphalt in roads.
- This program will accept residential and commercial shingles.
- For questions about commercial shingle recycling (apartments, multi-family units, and nursing homes) please call Metro Waste Authority at 244-0021.
- “Clean” loads of shingles will cost \$15 per ton at the Metro Park East Landfill and \$23 per ton at the Metro Park West Landfill. (Normal tipping fees are \$32.70 at Metro Park East and \$33 at Metro Park West.)
- Each contractor will need to sign a form at the scale house verifying that each load came from a residential home.
- A clean load is one with asphalt shingles only. Woodshake shingles are not allowed. Metal, trash and wood can be brought to the landfill but should be separated from the shingle load and thrown in the containers provided at the shingle recycling area prior to dumping.
- To get a “clean load” we recommend putting a tarp on the ground at the job site and throwing the metal, wood and trash onto it. You can then pick the tarp up and lay it over the shingles, tarp the load, and transport to the landfill. **Dirty loads will be charged normal tipping fees and be landfilled.**

## Accepted Materials for Shingle Recycling

<b>“Yes”</b>	<b>“No”</b>
(Include these items for recycling)	(Do NOT include these items with shingles. Keep these items separated.)
Clean, asphalt shingles  (if separated in the load from the other items on the “NO” list)	Wood
	Metal (such as flashing, gutters, plumbing stacks, etc.)
Felt or tar paper	Plastic or vinyl (such as vents, gutters, buckets, wrap, etc.)
	Paper waste
Nails in the shingles	Mastic or plastic roofing cement
	Rolled roofing materials (excess felt)
	Other garbage, trash or dirt
	Nail coils
