Consent Agenda Items for Approval

8. Resolution 05-24-03 – Approval of Semi-Annual Bond Payment to Polk County – Action for Approval
Payment to Polk County for bond issuance for Metro Recycling Facility (MRF) and refinance of the Metro Northwest Transfer Station (MNTS) occurs in November and May. The November payment is interest only and the May payment is principal and interest. The May 2024 payment is \$3,266,050.00. This payment completes all amounts owed relative to the MNTS refinancing, which was set up on a shorter amortization period (four years) than the amounts related to the MRF financing, which will run through 2040. Staff recommends approval.
9. Resolution 05-24-04 – Approval of Equipment Purchase for Metro Park East Landfill – Action for Approval
For over 20 years, staff have retrofitted and converted Bobcat Toolcats for litter control at Metro Park East Landfill. The purchase of the Bobcat UW56 Toolcat would be retrofitted to a current machine. A quote was received from Capital City Equipment company for \$65,00.00. The purchase is budgeted. Staff recommends approval.

ITEM:

Approval of Semi-Annual Bond Payment to Polk County

SUMMARY:

This payment to Polk County for bond proceeds related to the Material Recovery Facility (MRF) and refinance of the Metro Northwest Transfer Station (MNTS) occurs semiannually.

DISCUSSION POINTS:

Semi-annual payments to Polk County for bond issuance for the original financing of the MRF and the refinancing of MNTS are scheduled in November and May, until May 2040. Each November payment is interest only, and each May payment is principal and interest. The principal and interest payment is due by May 31, 2023, in the amount of \$3,226,050.00. This payment completes all amounts owed relative to the MNTS refinancing, which was set up on a shorter amortization period (four years) than the amounts related to the MRF financing, which will run through 2040.

ITEM:

Approval of Equipment Purchase for Metro Park East Landfill (MPE)

SUMMARY:

The purchase of a Bobcat UW56 Toolcat would be retrofitted with a litter vac unit from an existing machine and used for litter collection at MPE.

DISCUSSION POINTS:

For over 20 years, staff have retrofitted and converted Bobcat Toolcats for litter control at MPE. The high flow hydraulics are used to power the vac, the aux hydraulics is used to maneuver the pickup tube over litter. Litter is then blown into an enclosed box that is hydraulically dumped when full. This unit has 4WD and is great for off road use, it can collect as much litter in one hour as one person can collect in one day.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommend approval to purchase a Bobcat UW56 Toolcat from Capital City Equipment Company at the price of \$65,000.
